# School Rules and Regulations

School regulations apply when boys are in school, travelling to and from the School, or taking part in any school activity away from school, whether during term time or in the holidays. They are intended to ensure the welfare, safety and good order of pupils and staff. All pupils are expected at all times to show good manners, common sense, respect and consideration for each other, teaching and non-teaching staff, visitors and towards members of the public. The following more specific regulations seek to create a pleasant and disciplined atmosphere and appropriate teaching and learning environment.

## 1. GOOD ORDER AND DISCIPLINE

Pupils must act at all times with consideration for all members of the community.

Pupils are expected to be committed both to their academic work and to the extra-curricular life of the School. There is an expectation, if selected by the School to participate in school matches, practices or rehearsals and other out of school activities, to attend on school days, weekends and before term unless special exemption is given.

Full attendance is expected at school. Only for compassionate reasons, where possible requested in writing well in advance by the parent or guardian, will a pupil be given leave of absence. All pupils are expected to register twice a day at the designated times. Any pupil arriving late must report to Reception immediately on arrival in order to register, for fire, safety and security reasons.

Boys arriving after the register has been taken should go straight to Reception and sign themselves into the Late Book. If a boy fails to register his lateness, and there has been no notification of a planned or unplanned absence, his parents will immediately be contacted to confirm his whereabouts. This may lead to anxiety on the part of the parents and therefore it is most important that the correct lateness procedure is followed.

A pupil arriving late twice in a week will receive a Community detention. A pupil who is late five or more times in a half term will be required to pre-register with the Head of Year at 8.15am every morning for two weeks. Failure to attend pre-registration or further late arrival at school will result in a boy being removed from lessons and being sent home.

No boy in Years 7-11 may leave the School site during school hours, unless given permission to do so. If a boy in Years 7-11 needs to leave school because of a planned absence, he must wait in Reception to be collected by a parent or guardian who will sign him off the premises. When a boy is brought back to school, he will be required to sign in the same book to register his return. If the parent or guardian is unable to collect the boy formal written consent must be given to Reception before he leaves the School premises.

Bullying in any form is not tolerated.

## 2. ABSENCE

When a boy is absent without prior notification e.g. through illness, parents are requested to telephone or email ([absence@johnlyon.org](mailto:absence@johnlyon.org)) the School between 8.00 a.m. and 8.30 a.m. on each day. If a boy is absent from registration and we have received no communication from parents the School will contact parents by telephone.

If a boy is absent the School requires an absence note. This can be written and delivered to the School Office directly, or via the boy's Form Tutor, but the easiest method is by email

([absence@johnlyon.org](mailto:absence@johnlyon.org)) via a parental email account.

For long term absence any communication should be received within the first three days of absence. This covers the government's regulations relating to truancy and the School's responsibility for pupils in its care.

Permission for absences from school for part of a day must be sought from his Form Tutor or Head of Year in the first instance. Such requests can be made using the Request for Leave of Absence form and may be for medical or dental appointments, or for interviews or driving tests, not lessons. In all other cases permission of the Head should be sought, well in advance by email ([absence@johnlyon.org](mailto:absence@johnlyon.org)). It should be borne in mind that, whilst parents may explain absence, only the School may authorise it.

## 3. SCHOOL BOUNDS

Pupils in Years 7 – 11 are not permitted to leave the site during the day. The School bounds are Lower Road, Middle Path, the junction of Middle Road, Crown Street and Byron Hill Road. Sixth Formers are allowed to leave the School premises (on foot) at break or during the lunch hour but only as far as the top of Byron Hill Road or the bottom of Middle Road. They may leave the site at other times only with the permission of the Head of Sixth Form and must sign out in the book in the Thomas Blackwell Centre. Failure to do so will result in this privilege being withdrawn. Sixth Formers may only leave the site during break and lunch times, not during study periods.

Being out of bounds without permission is regarded as a serious offence. Pupils should not be in the following areas without the express permission of a member of staff: Sports Hall, Changing Rooms, Fitness Rooms and Swimming Pool; the Cricket Nets; the Science Laboratories; the Stage; the Music Practice Rooms; the Art Department; the Kitchen; all offices.

## 4. DRESS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

All pupils are expected to take pride in their appearance and to be smartly dressed.

Pupils must conform to the dress and appearance regulations at all times of the day when travelling to and from the School, and on all school occasions, unless alternative instructions are given by a member of staff.

Guidelines for hair: Pupils' hair styles should be that of a business professional, short and smart.

Steps/lines/shaved sides are not permitted.

- Hair should not be so short as that more scalp than hair is visible over any selected area. As a guide, grade 2 is suggested as the minimum length of hair to comply with this rule.
- Any style should not have any extreme difference in hair lengths.
- There should be no visible use of any hair product.
- Hair should be of a natural colour, with no highlights.

Those in any doubt should contact the relevant Head of Year, before any restyling.

Boys must be clean-shaven. Where, for religious reasons, parents wish their son not to shave, a letter requesting this must be sent to the Head of Year at the start of each term.

Unless worn discreetly for religious reasons, jewellery is not permitted at all; this includes

rings, necklaces, wristbands, bracelets, ear studs and earrings.

Books, apparatus or school property lost or damaged must be paid for or replaced. Any damage to school property, of whatever kind, must be reported at once to a member of staff.

All property must be clearly marked. Valuable items and substantial amounts of money must not be brought to school. During Games and Physical Education periods, valuables should be left in the pupil's secured locker.

No pupil may borrow another's property without his express permission. Wilful interference with, theft of, or damage to, personal or school property will be regarded as a serious offence. Accidental damage must be reported immediately to the Form Tutor or Head of Year.

Lost property: Boys are responsible for looking after their own property. All valuable items should be marked with the owner's name. Unidentifiable lost property can be claimed from the Reception.

Mobile telephones: refer to the Acceptable Use Policy.

Pupils must not have in their possession any dangerous items such as weapons, replica guns, chemicals or fireworks.

## 5. THE SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

All pupils should take a pride in the appearance of the School site.

The possession, or chewing, of gum on school premises or in school vehicles is not permitted.

All pupils are expected to eat in the refectory and dining room. All Sixth Formers buying school lunches must eat in the refectory. Sixth Formers may eat lunch brought from home in the Thomas Blackwell Centre.

## 6. PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

Pupils are not permitted to be in possession of prohibited drugs, tobacco, solvents or alcohol in school, on the way to and from school, or whenever it is possible to be identified as a member of the School community. Any failure to uphold this rule will be treated very seriously indeed.

## 7. PERSONAL TRANSPORT

The regulations governing the use of private transport may be obtained from the Head of Sixth Form. When parking on public roads, Sixth Form students must ensure that they do not obstruct any driveways or access roads. It is suggested that students should park either in Whitmore Road or at the bottom of West Street and walk through to the School via the Cricket Ground. Students should take care to park only in designated areas and not to park in any way that may obstruct traffic, notably on Byron Hill Road.

Pupils being driven to school by other Sixth Form pupils must produce their parents' consent in writing, in advance, to the Head of Sixth Form.

Students may not drive their cars or take lifts during the School day. Driving during lunch time is strictly prohibited.

Pupils may cycle to and from school but it is their responsibility to see that their bicycles are in good working order and they should be left in the racks provided and properly padlocked. The School cannot take responsibility for their safety or insurance.

## 8. LIBRARY

Pupils must maintain a quiet working environment in the Library during break and lunch times. During the working day we insist on silence in the Library.

The Library stock is protected by a library security system. Tampering or interference with any part of the system will be regarded as a serious offence.

No food or drink may be consumed in the Library. The full library regulations are on display in the Library.

## 9. COMPUTERS AND I.T. FACILITIES

All pupils are expected to sign and follow the Pupil Acceptable Use Policy before being allowed access to our computer system. Any breach of this code will be treated as a serious matter.

These regulations may be amended from time to time. The Student Council will be asked to contribute to the discussion on any changes or recommendations. It is important to realise that any breach of regulations is likely to result in some form of sanction. The School will be the final arbiter of interpretation of the regulations and of the appropriate form of sanction if one is deemed necessary.

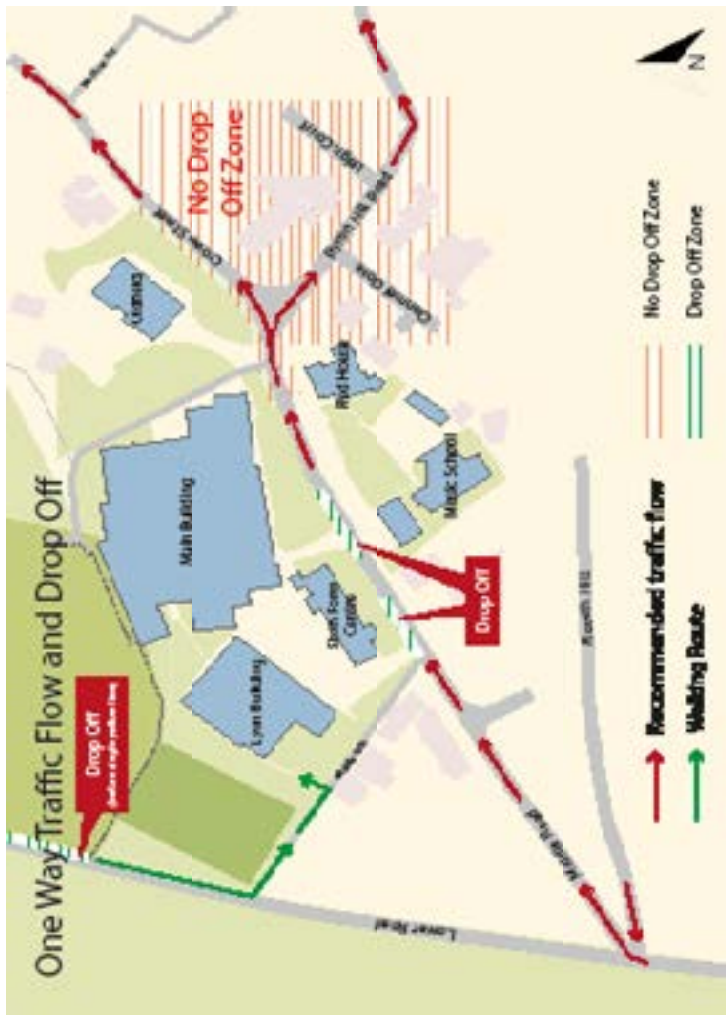
